White-tailed deer are animals with four toes on each foot, two large ones with hooves and two smaller ones behind those called dew claws. The male deer grow antlers that they lose in the winter and grow again in the spring. Deer feed on plants such as twigs, lichens, grasses, buds and fruit. White-tailed deer raise their tails to alert others of potential danger.
