



Bumble Bee

There are over 20 species of native bumble bees in Minnesota. Bumble bees are fuzzy due to the hairs on their body. Some species of female bumble bees have little pollen sacks on their hind legs into which they pack pollen that they gather to eat. The queen is the only member of the colony to live through the winter and in the spring she starts a new hive.
