



Green Heron

Green Herons are water birds with yellow/orange legs that can be seen wading in shallow water along the edge of a lake, pond, or wetland looking for food to catch. They have been known to use small bits of twigs, feathers, or insects to use as bait to lure fish nearer for them to nab. They are often hard to see as they hold very still along the edge of the water and you may not notice them until you see them flying away at the sound of your approach.
